DECLARATIVE

A declarative sentence is used to make a **statement**.

E.g. This town is dreary.



INTERROGATIVE

A declarative sentence is used to ask a **question**.

E.g. Is the town dreary?

EXCLAMATORY

A declarative sentence is used to make an **exclamation**.

E.g. What a dreary town!



IMPERATIVE

A declarative sentence is used to issue an order or give a **command**.

E.g. Get me out of this dreary town!
